Adler Affiliate Program ~

We will be taking a vote on joining the Adler Affiliate Program at the general meeting. International Year of Astronomy (2009) ~

We will also be discussing and possibly voting on RAS involvement in the "International Year of Astronomy" celebration being planned by the Manfred Olson Planetarium (UW-Milwaukee).
